Corfe Hills is an ambitious and high performing upper school where every student is known and supported to succeed. We prioritise strong partnerships in the local community and joined Initio Learning Trust in October 2024. In our most recent Ofsted inspection, we were graded good in all categories.

We are seeking to appoint an Assistant Headteacher with proven leadership skills and a clear vision and to join Corfe Hills School from 1 September 2025. The successful candidate will lead on a broad portfolio which is likely to include aspects of curriculum leadership including timetabling and examinations in addition to other whole school responsibilities. You will work within a dedicated, talented and experienced senior leadership team, alongside teachers, support staff and our local school committee who are all committed to serving the school and its community.

Alongside the leadership team, our extended senior team include the Head of Sixth Form, Heads of Faculty (English, Maths and Science) and Heads of House for each of our three houses (Kimmeridge, Lulworth and Sandbanks).
